1. What is your motivation for seeking public office?

Why I'm running:

I love this country, the U.S. Constitution and the sacrifices our Founding Fathers made to establish them. 2. What are your views on the role of Government?

* I support entirely restructuring the Department of Motor Vehicles. DMV will have to live by the law (**NRS 485.317**) which states they are only to use the last several numbers of the Vehicle Identification Number – not the registered owner’s name. Drivers licenses should be issued for life unless suspended or revoked for criminal activities or serious driving violations. No one forgets how to drive. No more absurd drivers license renewals for people with good driving records! Insurance companies can request vision tests for older drivers, etc. No more smog test hassles. Cars that visually smoke will be subject to citation. Road construction and repair revenue can be obtained by invoicing Nevada vehicle title holders.

* I support abolishing the taxing of parents for public schooling if they want to send their children to a private school. The remainder of public schools will no longer follow the dictates of federal directives. Curriculum and class offerings will encourage learning - not test taking results.

8. What is your stance on ownership of firearms?

The Second Amendment!

9. What sorts of restrictions or bans should be in place?

Everyone should be allowed to carry Concealed Weapons without a permit.
