## Questionnaire for Those Seeking Public Office

1. What is your motivation for seeking public office? I have worked for Constitutional Government my entire life. **I have supported constitutionally limited government. We must renew our liberties through regaining our rights. I think I can be the conscience of the Legislature is protecting Liberty.**
2. What are your views on the role of Government? What should be the role of Federal Government? What should be the role of State Government? **Government is the servant of the people. Government is limited in its scope by the State and Federal Constitutions. The State Governments created the Federal Government. The balance between states and the federal government is way out of balance with the Feds having much too much power. The role of the Federal Government is defined and limited by the US Constitution and whatever is not delegated to the Feds belongs as the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> amendments state to the States and the people. The powers of the state government are also limited by the Constitutions.**
3. If your views of Government differ from what is taking place now, what would you do to move Government closer to your vision of how it should operate? **We must limit government by living within the constitutionally delegated powers. We can limit the heavy hand of government by limiting taxation and revenues, by insisting the government abide by the Constitution. This is not an easy or an instant process. We must oppose unfunded federal mandates, we must not impose unfunded mandates on the counties and cities, we must jealously guard our citizens' rights, we must repudiate/nullify laws that violate the Constitution like Obamacare.**
4. What shapes your views on how to vote for or against legislation? If you are running for the office of Governor please explain what shapes your approval or veto of legislation? (For Legislative and Gubernatorial Candidates) **My philosophy of limited Constitutional government determines my views on how I will vote.**
5. Give us some idea of the type of legislation you would most likely introduce? What do you feel is the most urgent and important legislation?(Non Legislative Candidates Exempt) **I would support legislation to oppose Obamacare at the State level. I would support constitutional immigration legislation similar to what has passed OK, AZ, and MO. I would work to improve our gun laws and concealed carry. I would oppose tax increases. I would work for a Nevada State Bank and Nevada Silver Coin Bill which help Nevada's economy. I would promote oil drilling in Nevada. I would support Nevada returning to the standards of the 10<sup>th</sup> amendment wherever we can apply it.**

6. What is your stance on ownership of firearms? What sorts of restrictions or bans should be in place? Your views on Concealed Weapons Permits? **I have a CCW. I would work to repeal the Gun Registration in Clark County which is of concern to all Nevadans. I believe that Freedom's Precious Metals are Gold, Silver and LEAD. I think we should move ultimately to all every law abiding citizen to carry without a permit. I believe in the individual right to Keep and Bear Arms.**
7. Would you be willing to help a pro choice helmet bill to the governor's desk for passage? **Yes. I have supported it in the past.**
